PATRIMONY AND TOURISM COLLECTION MEDINA NOGALTE PUERTO LUMBRERAS



The Medina Nogalte Patrimony and Tourism collection is situated on the left side of the Rambla de Nogalte, in the town centre of Puerto Lumbreras and in one of the most elevated points of the town.

The Islamic medieval fortress(Nogalte Castle), built in the 12th Century stands out, together with the numerous cave houses (more than one hundred) excavated in the heart of the area in and around the castle, were built as one of the most individual troglodyte enclaves on the south east peninsular.

Through the distinct thematic cave houses, as well as imaging life in these peculiar constructions, visitors can learn about aspects of the cultural and ethnographic patrimony of Puerto Lumbreras.

CRAFT MAKERS' WORKSHOP HOUSE

You can get to know the distinct types of crafts which are produced in the locality, submerging yourself in workshops which evoke the artisan trades.

"THE NOGALTE HILL" CAVE: RECUPERATING OUR HISTORY

Through this cave you can learn about the process of recovery and reconstruction of Medina Nogalte.

"LIFE AND TRADITIONS IN THE CAVE HOUSES" CAVE

The aim here is to get to know the peculiarities and evolutions in the use of the overhangs and caves by humans in the south east peninsular and Puerto Lumbreras from prehistory until recent times (The 1950s/60s).

"WATERWAYS IN PUERTO LUMBRERAS" CAVE

This cave is dedicated to presenting the importance of water in the town, establishing the journey from its collection, storage and distribution until its use in the different traditional and current activities.

"NOGALTE CASTLE" CAVE

The thematic contents related to history, construction techniques and functions of the Islamic medieval fortress are presented, as well as the archeological investigation and the most representative discoveries.

"SCHOOL" CAVE

In it the visitor will know how the school was and the teaching in the middle of the s. XX in Puerto Lumbreras; as it was the day to day in the school, didactic materials and furniture that they used.
