


SIERRA ESPUÑA WAS SHAPED BY THE WHIMS OF NATURE

Thanks to this never-ending work, today you have the opportunity to practice adventure sports in an unparalleled protected natural environment.

The caves of La Matea, El Churtal and La Pólvora are great options for **spelunking** and for visiting the depths of Sierra Espuña.

Back at the surface we have the Leyva ravine, an ideal setting for rock climbing. But if you're more into the canyoning and want an adrenaline rush, there are two places to choose: the Lébor and El Ciervo ravines.






Near El Ciervo there is also a **via ferrata** (which can be combined with the canyon) located right at the gates of the Natural Park.

We now take to the skies to offer you the chance to see Sierra Espuña while paragliding or from a hot-air balloon, whichever you prefer.

Also at a high altitude, although a little more moderate, we have the multi-adventure area of the Las Alquerías Nature Classroom. You'll have a great time: they have zip lining, abseiling, slackline, tree climbing and a monkey bridge.

When the sun gets scorching hot, it's a good time to soak in the water, and a great place to do so is the La Cierva reservoir, which is also perfectly equipped for paddle surfing.











For those who prefer the peace and quiet of direct contact with the nature and culture of Territorio Sierra Espuña, we have two proposals: yoga in the middle of the forest and the activity A Day with the Shepherd.

Yes, really!! The idea is to spend a day in the company of a shepherd and learn all the secrets of the trade.

The variety of Territorio Sierra Espuña is what makes it special.

WATCHING BIRDS IN THEIR NATURAL HABITAT WILL CAPTIVATE YOU, AND IN SIERRA ESPUÑA YOU'LL HAVE A GREAT TIME

With the majesty of the two undisputed monarchs of the park: the golden eagle and the booted eagle.

But remember that they are not alone up there. The peregrine falcon and the goshawk are other birds of prey spectacularly soaring through the Murcian sky.

Other smaller birds, known as passerines, also have their home in the Mediterranean mountains: crossbills, cirl buntings and black wheatears.

Rest assured, you will return home with an album full of pictures that you probably won't be able to capture anywhere else.

And this is no coincidence:
Sierra Espuña has been a Special
Protection Area for birds since 1998,
thanks largely to the golden eagle
and eagle owl communities living in
the area.

IF YOU ENJOY CYCLING, THIS IS THE PLACE FOR YOU

Getting to know Sierra Espuña by bike is a great plan no matter who you come with. In the park you have options designed for all types of cyclists, whether you come with your family, with your friends or as a couple.

For those who like to feel the adrenaline in contact with the land, Espubike is the correct option. A four-stage circular route takes you through some of the most beautiful spots in the area.

The small village of El Berro, the towns of Gebas and Casas Nuevas, and the pine forest of Las Alquerías are some of them.

But if you prefer speed, with Espuroad you can also enjoy to the fullest.









Three road routes border the mountains starting from the towns close to Sierra Espuña.

If you want to go deep into the green heart, they can also take you there.

What's more, if you're up for a challenge, you're going to love the Espubike Challenge.

It is an official route starting at the Sierra Espuña campsite in El Berro. They will provide you with everything you need to do it. Also, keep in mind that you'll get a free gift if you complete it.

So now you know: don't forget your bike on your next trip to Sierra Espuña.


Choose how you want to explore: around the park's massif or crossing the mountain range.

OPEN YOUR EYES WIDE AND TAKE A DEEP BREATH

When was the last time you stopped and enjoyed the moment?


With these **panoramic views**, time stands still.

In Sierra Espuña you can once again feel the peace that only nature can provide.

A green landscape bathed in silence, broken only by some birds chirping, a branch swaying in the wind... Or a bird of prey announcing its presence. In the park the atmosphere is so clean that you can clearly see the landscape, beautifully adorned in natural tones.

This is actually our recommendation: join us to contemplate the immensity of this landscape from 10 natural viewpoints, veritable balconies to admire nature.

We recommend coming at dawn to admire the light changes over mountains and treetops, in a fascinating display that repeats when the sun goes down.





From up there you can see some of the highest peaks of Sierra Espuña: Morrón de Totana and Pedro López, both almost 1,600 metres above sea level.


Other peaks such as Peña Apartada, Morrón de Alhama, Paredes de Leyva, and Morrón Chico are not far behind.

During the tour, which you can do on foot or by car, you will sometimes be surrounded by the dense pine forest of the Espuña river valley and the plains of the Guadalentín valley.

You will be able to walk next to a sinkhole, see the old Snow Wells and enjoy the scent of pine trees and flowers, so typical of this environment.

Don't forget to pack a snack; our favourites are local almonds and walnuts, Murcian dry figs and a good sandwich, of course!

You can also visit the viewpoints in the company of a park guide who will be happy to tell you all about the history and peculiarities of the landscape in front of you.

IN TERRITORIO SIERRA ESPUÑA, GASTRONOMIC TOURISM IS A MUST

An opportunity to discover our fresh and healthy local cuisine. Food coming out of steaming pots to feed both your body and your soul.

With the pride of those know its value, our cuisine is part of the only gastronomy declared Intangible Cultural Heritage by UNESCO: the Mediterranean Diet.

Intimately linked to our land and way of life.

Based on two of our most prized treasures, vegetable gardens and mountains, which sometimes join forces with the sea to

bring simple but wisely combined dishes to your table.

The orchards of Territorio Sierra Espuña are famous for their fruit and vegetables, among which citrus fruits shine brightest.

Not too far away, we find masterfully cultivated olive groves that provide us with local and sustainable olive oil.

Followed by the intense flavours of pickled and preserved olives, and top-quality fruits worthy of any renowned restaurant.

Dried fruits such as almonds, walnuts and pistachios are also highly prized for their quality and every year they dress our landscapes in beautiful colours.











If you like honey, let us tell you: you have never tasted honey like ours. Local and organic, of course.

We conclude this tour with the aromatic and medicinal herbs used to season the dishes of Territorio Sierra Espuña. And, of course, good bread, always present on our tables.

With such a well-stocked pantry, there is no need to go far to find authentic *local produce*.

We have two options for you: you can enjoy them in our restaurants or buy them at the different shops and take them home with you.



Make your own path as you walk at the heart of Sierra Espuña

Choose your route amongst the variety we offer and remember to never leave the path or road.

If you are more into adventure, all you need is your trekking equipment to explore the 101.59 kilometres of **traditional tracks and trails** organised in 6 stages.

These routes offer you breathtaking panoramic views and allow you to get to know a historic forest that speaks to you around every corner.

It will tell you about the passing of "el apóstol del árbol" (Quevedo, sometimes called the apostle of the tree), who was a real breath of fresh air at a time when it seemed that the park was dying; about how the mountains you walk on became one of the first ecological refrigerators in the world.









BUT IT ALSO TAKES YOU ON A JOURNEY

Along paths that cross the dense pine forest of Las Alquerías; to see the Mare Nostrum from the Pilón viewpoint; or to get to know El Berro, a beautiful mountain village.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE

The near-mystical experience of touching the sky from the 1,568-metre-high summit of the second highest peak, Pedro López.

Taking a walk through the magnificent moonlike landscape of Barrancos de Gebas and recharging your batteries in one of the village's lodgings.

Or, why not, waiting for nightfall to lie on the ground and contemplate a sky bursting with stars.

You've never seen anything like it! Here's a safety tip: if you decide to walk around Sierra Espuña on your own, stop by the Ricardo Cordorniú Visitor Centre to tell us about your plans. We will be happy to help you with anything you need.

WHAT IS ECOTOURISM?



At first glance, it seems like it's all about travelling to natural environments and enjoying all the wonders that green spaces have to offer, right?

Well, you're on the right track, but it's important to know that ecotourism goes much further than that, actually. Because the point of ecotourism is to be responsible and to know that the protection of biodiversity is the only way to have fun in harmony with nature.

To be grateful for everything it gives us.

To contribute to the socio-economic development of the Sierra Espuña area by choosing our destination to enjoy any of the experiences we offer you.

Our flag is the deepest respect for Territorio Sierra Espuña, and this is also the fundamental requirement that we ask of you and all our visitors.

So please read our decalogue of a good ecotourist carefully.





DECALOGUE OF A GOOD ECOTOURIST

TO BE A TOP CLASS ECOTOURIST, FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES CLOSELY:

- Respect and preserve the environment in all its extension, as well as any living being or natural or cultural element that you might find during your stay in Sierra Espuña.
- Leave the area even cleaner than you found it.
 You will find waste bins in the Recreational Areas,
 and you can always take your litter back with you
 to a recycling centre.
- Do not feed wild animals; they have their own diet and our food can cause diseases and may even be lethal to them. Avoid shouting or making noises that may disturb park inhabitants or other visitors.
- Find out about the activities you can do in the park and always leave your vehicle in the designated areas.
- Follow all the signs and indications of the staff to the letter. Never leave the trails and paths, as they are designed to maintain a peaceful environment for the flora and fauna.
- 6. **Do not smoke or throw cigarette butts** in the park and, of course, do not light any fires.
- 7. If you want to visit Sierra Espuña in the company of your furry best friend, you must keep them **leashed and close to you** at all times.
- Maintain an appropriate speed when riding a mountain bike or on the road, and never leave the marked trails. Always ride on the right and wear a helmet, as well as other protective measures.
- Taking home any species from the park, whether animal or plant, is strictly forbidden. Do not pick flowers or break tree branches. Do not alter or modify the natural environment even a little bit.
- 10. Do not forget to contact the local population; they will help you live an authentic ecotourism experience.
